A free resource for students and great for GCSE practice and test themselves. Some students use this in other subjects and have also found it useful for GCSE Spanish. Choose AQA Spanish GCSE options. This supports learning and revising vocabulary, grammar and all GCSE topics.

Kerboodle – Y12 and 13 have their own passwords for this and are used to using it to access resources and assessments. The new Exam Pulse sections are excellent for revision of the topic for the exam.

TV monde: choose your level and your topic and read interesting articles with exercises to do about them.

Languagesonline has lots of useful sections depending on your level. We really recommend the Grammar sections for revision of verbs and tenses. Some interesting A level bits too that you probably haven't used in class.

Quizlet.com is a fun way to practise vocabulary. For Year 7 and 8 search the name of your textbook and module eg Dynamo 1 Module 2 and it will come up with sets of vocabulary to revise what you have covered in class. Our favourites are Match and Gravity but it also has really useful "test yourself" sections.

You can also create your own sets of vocabulary and for GCSE students it could be useful to prepare sets for your GCSE speaking questions on here.
